State Meet Judging Selection

- 1. Women Judges will have application filled out and in the High School Judging Liaison (Jack Dunlop) by February 1st
- 2. Judging Liaison will pull together all judges from each region and send out an email to the Regional Chairs with a list of judges who have applied from their area.
- 3. Regional Chairs will then collect from the coaches in their region the top two picks.
- 4. Regional Chairs will then put up their top two picks on a conference call.
 - Top Judge (#1 Pick) in each region will never be voted out
 - Second Choice Judge this will be further discussed
 - Unanimous vote, 3 out of 4
 - Never be voted out
 - Discussion may lead to a judge being voted out
 - Each Region will also put up an alternate judge; this is in case one of the top 8 judges is unable to judge the State meet.
 - Putting up a 9th judge (Meet Referee), will allow for a replacement with short notice
- 5. After the Regional Chairs have picked their top 8 judges, then it will be up to the High School Judging Liaison (Jack Dunlop) to assign the events.

It has been mentioned that there is no representation from Region 2 on the Executive Board, so Mark Sherman has asked Juergen Achtermann to represent and voice opinions for Region 2. Everyone on call agreed to this addition.

Mark Sherman is going to ask Cameron Sweny to gather a list of non-paid schools that will be emailed to the Regional Chairs. Regional Chairs will then need to contact each school to make sure they are aware and will take care of it by the deadline of Nov. 15th.
