5) (only if #3 fails) Revert to: all around qualifiers to state must place in the top 8 and meet the qualifying score:

Each region will qualify their ten (10) highest scoring individual event finishers that score at, or above the qualifying score, and their eight (8) highest scoring All Around finishers that meet or exceed the qualifying score. All gymnasts competing in all events (4 for girls, 6 for boys) are eligible to enter the all around competition. If more than two AA's in the top 10 are from the same team, then the next AA'S that meet the qualifying score and are not on one of the state qualifying teams, will be recognized on the stand and qualify to state. (No maximum) (revised GAT 2019).

Discussion: Why we started this- to get more representation and more schools to the state competition. What happened at the last state meet was an exception not a norm. Dropping from 10-8 can run into the same situation that we dealt with at the 2022 State meet. We had kids that shouldn't have been at the State championships. Needs to be the best of the best.

To Amend the Proposal: Top 10 All-Around and Top 10 individual events and meet a qualifying score. – NOT AMENDING
