

2003 ALL AMERICAN AWARDS

ALL AMERICAN COACH OF THE YEAR

To nominate a coach for the NHSGCA's "Coach of the Year" award, the following procedures must be followed:

- A. The nomination must be made by a State Coaches Association or is equivalent. (Exceptions can be made for special situations by the NHSGCA's president.)
- B. The nominee must be a current member of the NHSGCA and a member last year.
- C. The nominee must be a gymnastic coach of an accredited high school.
- D. A statement explaining the method of selection by the nominating association must be included. (A coach can receive this award only once in a 5 year period.)
- E. A resume of the nominee's background in high school coaching, the name of the school principal, the school's address and the name & address of the local newspaper must be included.
- F. Two 3 3/8 x 2 3/8 (wallet size) photos must be included.
- G. A \$65 application fee must be included to defray costs.
- H. The nomination must be post marked prior to July 1, 2003 to be accepted. Mail your nomination to Todd Vesely, President-NHSGCA.

All American Teams

To nominate a team for All American honors, follow these procedures

- A. The coach must be a current member of the NHSGCA.
- B. The Team Score is based on the accumulation of three raw scores on each event according to the current NFSHSA rules.
- C. These scores are to be an average of three competitions, one of which must be in a championship competition (ie., 5 or more team invitational, League, Regional or State Meet series.) Exceptions can be made by the NHSGCA's President.
- D. The score sheets must clearly show the competition involved (see point "c") and must be signed by the Head Judge, Coach and Athletic Director.
- E. The use of the All American Averaging Scoring form must be used. (The form is available for photocopying in the back of the Yearbook)
- F. A typed or printed list of the team members names, the name of your principal and your school's address, must be submitted.
- G. A \$5.00 application fee plus \$2.00 per certificate is required covering team members, coaching staff, managers and any other special individuals like your trainer or athletic director.
- H. Non-returnable score sheets or copies of the original score sheets must be postmarked prior to July 1, 2003 to be accepted. Mail the Women's Team nomination to Margie Canfield, Women's Vice President and the Men's Team Nomination to Eric Liva, Men's Vice President.
- I. Qualifying Scores:

- J. Honorable Mention: If your women's team averaged between 95.00 and 97.49 or if your men's team averaged between 125.00 and 127.49, your team is eligible for 2 honorable mention certificates (for the coach and the school). A fee of \$10.00 is required. Send your request to Margie Canfield or Eric Liva.

All American Gymnasts

To nominate a gymnast for All American honors observe the following procedures.

- A. The coach must be a member of the NHSGCA.
- B. The qualifying score must be an average based upon five competitions, two of which must be from tournament of five or more teams and/or from a league, regional, sectional or state meet series (exceptions can be made by the NHSGCA's president.)
- C. The non-returnable score sheets or copies of the original score sheets must clearly indicate; 1. The gymnast's full name 2. The scores awarded 3. The signature of the head judge, coach and your athletic director.
- D. The use of All American Averaging Scoring Form for each nominated gymnast MUST be used and contain the following; 1. The age of the gymnast 2. The class in school of the gymnast 3. The All American average you computed with the meet sites and dates 4. What college the gymnast plans to attend after graduation (if known and for seniors only)
- E. A \$5.00 application fee per gymnast plus \$1.00 per event must be included.
- F. The non-returnable score sheet or copies of the original score sheets must be post marked prior to July 1, 2003. Mail the Women's All American Gymnast nomination to Margie Canfield, Vice president; and the Men's All American Gymnast nominations to Eric Liva, Vice president.

- H. Honorable Mention: Even if your team did have an All American individual, a coach can request honorable mention status for one or two of their most deserving gymnasts. No scores need to be submitted. Your recommendation only is needed. A fee of \$10.00 is required for either one or two certificates (no duplicates will be sent). Send requests to Margie Canfield or Eric Liva.

NOTE: The All American Team certificates and the All gymnast certificates will be mailed blank. Many coaches have them filled in by means of calligraphy.
